

HOW TO GET THERE

The **Aztec Hotel & Spa** can be reached as follows:

By Car GPS: N 51° 32' 31.028" W 2° 34' 7.26"

• **From the M4 Junction 20:**

- Join M5 (South West) and keep to nearside lane as lanes merge
- M5 Junction 16 is only a short distance from M4.
- Exit J16, stay in left filter lane, turn left at roundabout towards Bristol/Filton.
- Move across to centre lane ready for next large roundabout. Hotel will be on left.

• **From the M5 travelling south:**

- Leave the M5 at junction 16.
- At exit, stay in left filter lane, turn left at roundabout towards Bristol/Filton
- Move across to centre lane ready for next large roundabout. Hotel will be on left.

• **From the M5 travelling north:**

- Leave the M5 at Junction 16
- At the junction roundabout turn right
- At the next roundabout you will see the hotel on your right

By Train

- From **Bristol Parkway**: 3 miles
- From **Bristol Temple Meads**: 10 miles

By Air

Bristol Airport: 20 miles
